

## FIRE SAFETY REGISTER - PIONEER CENTRE

**THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT**

- It is a regulation of the Qld Fire Service that a record of camp occupants (residential overnight guests) is kept in case of an emergency.
- This needs to be completed for each night of camp. Full names (first and last names) are required.
- Camp leader must keep a copy in a safe place whilst on camp. They need to make sure it is on hand in the event of an emergency when a roll call needs to be made at the designated evacuation point.
- On departure from camp, a copy must be left with the QCCC office (or email it before camp)
- It is very important that guests stay in the room they are allocated.
- Room Leaders must ensure that all occupants vacate the cabin in the event of an evacuation
- The number of occupants per room must never exceed the number of beds.
- Beds and mattresses MUST NOT BE MOVED
